In April we will continue learning about **'Springtime / The Farm.'**

When outside try to look out for seasonal changes like Spring Flowers growing, buds on the trees, birds' nests or baby animals like lambs or calves in the fields if you are out for a walk or drive.

Stories – This month we will be reading some more information books on Spring, as well as books about baby animals and the farm. If you are visiting the Library please look out for stories on our theme to share with our child and keep a look out for changes associated with Spring in the environment!

Colour / Shape–

Our colour this month is **yellow**. Please encourage your child to look out for yellow objects in their environment. You could send them on a colour hunt in the house, asking them to bring you back some yellow items!

Our shape for this month is **Oval** to coincide with lots of talk about eggs at this time of the year!
